This Week's Focus

<u>Math</u> - This week we are continuing our study of customary/metric length and capacity. There will be a study guide going home on Monday and a test this week on Thursday.

<u>Science -</u> The space projects were awesome! It's always scary when students present their first oral project, but they always do extremely well.

We will continue our study of forces and motion by studying weight and gravitational pull. This unit will unite math weight/measurement standards and physical science standards.

<u>Reading-</u> We are reading the novel "My Life as a Book." We will focus on drawing inferences with text support.
