<u>Math</u>- Students learning how to multiply 2 digits by 2 digits using various strategies to solve. They are also learning problem solving strategies when using multiplication.

<u>Science</u>- Students are continuing to track the current weather conditions in Jasper, New York City and Sao Paulo, Brazil.

We will be comparing these different regions and discussing the difference and similarities. <u>REMINDER: Weather project information went home on Friday, October 13. It is due on November 2.</u>

Reading: We will begin the nonfiction book, "Georgia, What's So Great About This State?" We will be learning about all things Georgia. This is a 31 page book, so we will have a vocabulary quiz at the end of the book.

Vocabulary words are: heading, subheading, caption, valley, plateau, plain, plantation, region, piedmont, sacrifice, monument, traditions, natural resources, colonize, & symbols. A study guide will be given. This is a great time to talk about places that you have visited in Georgia & look at pictures you have taken!

Grammar: We are still working on progressive tense verbs. We will also be working on helping verbs. Here is a song with a list of the helping verbs. The students will have to know all 23 helping verbs and will have a quiz where they have to list them all. (No quiz this week) Helping verbs, helping verbs, there are 23!

Am, is, are, was and were, being, been, and be, Have, has, had, do, does, did, will, would, shall and should. There are five more helping verbs: may, might, must, can, could!

Writing: We are working on Informational writing.

Social Studies: We will be studying about the formation of the 13 Colonies.
