 $\underline{\text{Math}}$ - Students learning how to multiply 2 digits by 2 digits using various strategies to solve. They are also learning problem solving strategies when using multiplication . Science- Students are now graphing the data about the current weather conditions in Jasper, New York City and Sao Paulo, Brazil. We will be analyzing these different regions and determining the difference and similarities.

REMINDER: Weather project information went home on Friday, October 13. It is due on November 2.

Reading: We are reading the nonfiction book, "Georgia, What's So Great About This State?" We have been learning & discussing various places in Georgia. The students have been really excited to share the places that they have visited in GA. This is a 31 page book, so we will have a vocabulary quiz at the end of the book. Vocabulary words are: heading, subheading, caption, valley, plateau, plain, plantation, region, piedmont, sacrifice, monument, traditions, natural resources, colonize, & symbols. A study guide has been given. Book Fair: Students will visit the book fair as a class on 10/31.

Grammar: We are working on helping verbs. Here is a song with a list of the helping verbs. The students will have to know all 23 helping verbs and will have a quiz where they have to list them all. (No quiz this week) Helping verbs, helping verbs, there are 23!
